The LL.B. Degree will not be conferred upon a candidate unless the candidate has passed in, or cleared, all the papers prescribed for each year examination in accordance with the provisions relating to each year examination. Performance of the student shall be evaluated by the Examination to be conducted at the end of every year and also by his/her performance in the Practical Training as per University rules and the guidelines issued from time to time by the Bar Council of India.

Admission to Three Year Law Course

A candidate passing the Bachelor's Degree Examination of the C.S.I.M. University in any faculty with minimum 45% marks or a corresponding degreeexamination of any other University recognized as equivalent there to by the C.S.I.M. University with the minimum prescribed marks at the first attempt will be eligible for admission to the First Year LL.B. The above percentage of marks shall be relaxed by 5% for candidates belonging to the SC/ST categories. Admission will be given through the Entrance Test or as per university rules and norms prescribed by BCI.

Procedure for seeking admission to Three year Courses.

Admission process for the first year of the three year Law Course will commence after the declaration of graduation results.

Total seats available

1 st year of LL.B. (Three years): 300

The prospectus and the admission forms will be available at the college office. The admission form, duly filled in, should be submitted to the college office within the prescribed time. Thereafter a merit list of the selected candidates will be displayed on the notice board. The selected students should seek admission within the specified time, notified on the notice board.







Admission Requirements

Admission must be taken by the student in person, by submitting the following documents:

- 1) Original Statement of marks with a certified copy of the same
- Passing Certificate and certified copy of document indicating of birth, for example, school leaving certificate.
- 3) Four recent passport size photographs.
- 4) In case of a student migrating from another university has to obtained Provisional Eligibility Certificate University. Without provisional eligibility certificate the admission will not be given as per the rules of C.S.J.M. University. Application for eligibility is to be made to the registrar, C.S.J.M. University, Kanpur.
- In case of a student from a college affiliated to university, transfer certificate (T.C.) from that College submitted. The application for such T.C. should be sent college in the prescribed form.
- Foreign student seeking admission should produce their and student visa at the time of admission. Foreign Student tourist visas or entry visas will not be considered.
- In case of student who have kept one term in another college affiliated to the C.S.J.M. University and desire to take admission this college for the next year. "No objection certificate" in prescribed from must be produced.

 At the time of admission every student must undertake to attend a minimum 75% of the total number of Lectures and practicals held during each year.





General Rules Regarding Discipline

- Students shall abide by any general or special rules made by the college authorities in regards to the conduct of the students both in and outside the college, and the decision of the college authorities shall be final. Parents and guardians are also presumed to have agree to these rules when their wards join the college.
 - (See the instructions on the admission from the notice put up from time etc.)
- Students should in their own interest read the college notices, including notices containing rules placed on the notice boards from time to time. It shall be the duty of each students to scan all the notice-boards daily.
- Students are required to dress decently and are not permitted to wear shorts in the college premises.
- Use of cell phones is strictly prohibited. Students found using cell phones in class are liable to be fines.

Act of Indiscipline

The following shall be deemed as acts of indiscipline:

- Resorting to ragging: A students involved in any such act is liable to be expelled from the college and in addition may undergo imprisonment and fine.
- Smoking consumption of alcoholic drinks, intoxicants and narcotic drugs.
- An act which causes destruction or defacing ofthe property of the college or organizing raids and breaking in to the premises of college.
- An act which interferes with the personal liberty of another person or subjects another to indulgently or involves physical violence or use of abusive language.





- 5) An act in breach of an undertaking given under the rules of discipline.
- 6) Refusal to establish or reveal identity in the premises of the college.
- An act which causes interference of outside persons or bodies or agencies in the functioning of the college.
- Dissemination and assertion of any false statement or tampering of certificates and records, whether with a view to seeking admission in a college or securing any benefit what so ever.
- Collection of funds for any program, picnic, excursion, project or activity without prior written permission of the appropriate authority.
- 10) Use of title of the college or title which includes the name of the college for sending any letter communication to the press or for distributing any document or literature or publication other than academic work, without prior written permission of the appropriate authority.
- 11) Use of the name or address of the college or its officers or other authorities for making any representation on behalf of any student or group of students to any public authority in India or else-where or to any person (including the press) other than a person responsible for the management of the affairs of the college.
- 12) An act which disrupt the smooth running of the college or environment conductive to the pursuit of knowledge or harmonious relationship between different groups of students.
- An act which tend to lower in the public estimate the image of the college or their officers.
- 14) An act of unruly and disorderly behavior at any competitions sports, cultural activities or other social or educational programs organized by the college.
- An act involving moral treaded.
- 16) Breach of ordinances and rules relating to attendance at lecture tutorials, tests, terminal or preliminary examination and progress to the satisfactions of the principal.
- 17) Being found in profession of goods or any material deemed objectionable by the principal of the college, (in such cases, the principal may take or direct to take of such goods procession material pending further enquiry, if necessary).
- 18) Any act of insubordination or rude behaviors or use of intemperate language towards the principal or any professor of the college or nonteaching staff.
- Generally, any other act of indiscipline which, in the opinion of the principal of the college in unbecoming of a student.

Examination

Standard of passing the yearly examination and rules of exemption:

Acandidates shall be" Passed"

- In the subject papers or practical training (if any), if he/she has secured minimum 45% of the total marks in the respective papers of practical training, and theory.
- In the subjects/papers the examination for which are conducted by the university of C.S.J.M. of the respective year, if he/she has secured minimum 45% of the total marks in every of the papers and an aggregate of48% of the marks in all papers he is appearing at the given attempt/examination.
- The candidates shall also be entitled to the benefit of allocable grace marks as per the university regulations.
- 4. The student may be exempted at his/her choice from appearing in any of papers, other than practical training paper, if he has secured 50% of the total marks in the paper at the examination and from appearing in any or either of the practical training paper, if he has secured 40% of the total marks in the paper at the examination.

To pass any of the year examination:

- A candidate must have passed in all the subjects of that year as per the provisions mentioned in the preceding rules.
- No candidate will be admitted to and allowed to appear at the examinations to be conducted at the end of the second, third year of three year LL.B course unless he has successfully passed the examination in practical training papers for the respective year to be conducted by the respective colleges affiliated to university of C.S.J.M. on behalf of the University,
 - C.S.J.M. on behalf of the University, with minimum of 45% of the marks.
- The result of the candidates appearing at the 3 years LLB. Course shall not be declared unless and until the candidate has declared passed in all papers respectively.
- A candidate, for being eligible for the first year examination must have completed the requisite attendance in the given year as per the university rules and regulations.





Procedure for Imposing Punitive Action

- Any student of the college who has committed one or more of the acts of indiscipline mentioned above shall be subjects to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the principal, who may refer the matter to the any professor or a committee or enquiry appointed for the purpose.
- Every student who has been alleged to have committed an act or acts of indiscipline shall be given an opportunity to be heard before any disciplinary action is taken against him/her.
- The principal may take any disciplinary action against a student on a report made to him/her by the professor or a committee or enquiry appointed for the purpose, as the case may be.
- All decisions taken by the principal in relation to the acts of indiscipline committed by a students shall be final and binding.

The Library

The Rizvi college of law library will provide students with extensive facilities to maximize their knowledge in the field of law. It is probably the most frequently visited section of the college. And most certainly the heaven for dedicated law students.

The students can avail library facilities from 9.30 a.m to 4.30 p.m timing is extended at the time of examination each students is provided with a library card at the beginning of the academic term, and this has to be renewed annually.
